1. Paul the Writer You ' ll need: paper, pencils or pens, and tape or push pins. Say: Paul was a writer. He wrote 13 books of the Bible with God ' s help. He wrote more books in the Bible than anyone else. Pass out the paper and pencils. Tell children to write 13 things they know about God.
