Fahrenheit 451 was written and published in 1953. It took nine days for Bradbury to finish the first draft called The Fireman and later, when he was urged to extend it by his publisher (the first version was only 25,000 words long), he doubled the amount in exactly nine days more. Fahrenheit 451 won a 1954 "Retro" Hugo Award, one of only four Best Novel Retro Hugos ever given, in 2004. In 1966 Fahrenheit 451 was adapted into a movie by Franois Truffaut.
