Get under the car and remove the bolts holding the protective skid pan over the transmission (if you have the 1.8-liter engine). Set the bolts aside somewhere safe. Pull down the edge of the pan and locate the transmission drain/fill plug. Remove the plug and slide your finger into the hole. You should feel fluid at the back edge of the hole.

The automatic transmission fluid level is checked (with the engine off and the car on level ground) using the dipstick (with the yellow marking) in the right end of the transmission housing. Remove the dipstick and wipe it off. Insert the dipstick and remove it. The fluid level should be between the upper and lower marks.

Hondas are unique because they don't need the engine running to check the transmission fluid; although, the engine still needs to be warm, but not hot. Run the engine for about five minutes, cycling through all the transmission settings at least once before you shut it off. Figure

Check the transmission fluid level by making sure the dipstick is in the locked position, then pull it out, wipe the tip with a rag and push it back down into the locked position. Pull the dipstick out again and look at the tip. There will be two lines or two dots engraved into the metal of the stick. The fluid level should be between these two marks.

Using the fluid pump, add fluid into the transmission through the filler plug.

If you have a shifting problem with your Honda manual, check the clutch hydraulics for leaks, particularly the clutch master. These have been known to leak, and when they do they can cause shifting problems, usually grinding into gears. In addition to checking the hydraulics, check the shift linkage for worn bushings.

How To Change Honda Manual Transmission Fluid ...

Park the Honda Shadow Spirit on flat ground and run the engine for about 20 minutes to warm the transmission fluid up. Turn off the engine. Locate the transmission dipstick cap on the side of the transmission and twist the cap in a counterclockwise motion to remove the cap from the transmission. Wipe the dipstick off with a shop rag.

Connect the transmission fluid pump to a bottle and drain out all of the fluid. Pump a small portion of new fluid into the fill plug to flush out any contaminants. Ensure that you have a little more transmission fluid than the volume listed in your owner's manual. Figure 5.
