Nursing staff work flexibly between both A&C and C&C, but typically one team rotates to C&C for eight weeks at a time. Nurses work 12-hour shifts (07:30-20:00 & 19:30- 08:00), with the ratio of nurses to patients being 1:1 for level 3 patients, and 1:2 for level 2 patients. Every patient will have a named nurse responsible for his or her care

The cardiac intensive care unit is split into two distinct areas (a blue and a pink side). In general, the unit is run by 2 senior nurses-in-charge with one responsible for clinical duties and one for bed management. The map in appendix 1 shows the approximate layout of these areas.

What intensive care involves. Patients on an ICU will be looked after closely by a team of ICU staff and will be connected to equipment by a number of tubes, wires and cables. There will normally be 1 nurse for every 1 or 2 patients. This equipment is used to monitor their health and support their bodily functions until they recover.
