Stand by your bike and grab the frame with both hands as you did before to turn your bike back up the right way. Then lean the bike against a wall. Using a clean rag and soapy water, wash the handlebars and the headset (the part where the handlebars meet the frame). Take care to clean well around the brake and gear levers.
