BOOK FOUR: THE EVANGELIST AND HIS ACCLAMATION (1951-1954) William Branham is a paradox in modern history. God gave him a vision of a new stage to his ministry - a "third pull" (to use the angel's words) - which would surpass everything God had done through him in the past. Inevitably, he offended some people.
